Library Scavenger Hunt November 25-29, 2024

Welcome to the University Library! Our goal is to encourage and empower you to access our wide array of resources on your own. Items in **blue** will need to be provided as proof of completion.

- 1. Begin at the Circulation Desk and grab a Student User's Guide. If you need assistance, you can return to the Circulation Desk at any time to ask for a hint, or you can use the chat feature on our webpage. Good luck!
- 2. You have a reading assignment for the first week of class, but your reference book isn't here yet. Not to worry! We might have a free copy in the Filipiniana Section. Ask a librarian at the desk if you can borrow *a book about Dr. Jose Rizal* for the Rizal 101 course.
- 3. Did you know that you can check your library records and renew your borrowed books online? Go to the OPAC station to open your account using the Sign with Google option and take a photo of your OPAC account. A librarian will be happy to point you in the right direction or assist you with the computer. Don't forget to return the book.
- 4. Want to read the news in today's newspaper? There are several local and national newspapers in the Periodicals Section. Check out the current news and write down the title of the editorial news and the newspaper. Keep that note!
- 5. Now that that's taken care of, you can focus on your other homework. You have a research project on the environment, but you don't know where to begin. Lucky for you, we have a Remote Library to help you get started! Use one of our computers at the Electronic Resources Section (ERS) or use your gadget and look up the Library website at <u>www.library.addu.edu.ph</u>, scroll down to find the Remote Library on the left side of the screen, click and open using your ADDU account. Once inside the Remote Library, explore to see the available databases on e-journals, e-books, and research tools. Name at least two of the databases available.
- 6. The databases include great peer-reviewed articles, but your professor also requires a book source for this project. Go back to the library's homepage and enter the keyword "environment" into the Search bar, and browse through the results.

- 7. Wow, too many options! Look at the filters under the search bar. Click on "Source Types" select "Books" to narrow it down to books inside the building. Once you've found one you like, look for the Call Number in the book's bibliographic description.
- **8.** But what is a "Call Number" and what do those funny numbers and letters mean? The Call Number is a combination of letters and numbers that represent the Author of the book and the classification of the book. Copy the Call Number and proceed to the given location.
- 9. Now, you're prepared to face the shelves (also known as The Stacks) on your own! Search the General Circulation Collection on the third floor for your book. When you've found it, take a selfie with the book cover. You can ask assistance from the Librarian and the Library shelver to find your book.
- 10. Oh no! You just heard the internet will be down for the rest of the day. You should head down to the Audio-Visual Center and find some DVDs to pass the time. While you're there, you may take a look at the AVC collections and materials! What materials did you see at the Audio-Visual Center aside from the DVDs? Name at least one.
- 11. As you make your way back to the entrance of the library, you notice the American Corner to the right. This Library is open to the public. There is a mural inside with images of famous landmarks and symbols in Davao City. Name one:
- 12. Did you find everything? Now, please proceed to the Miguel Pro Learning Commons to finish up, relax, and receive a surprise! To earn a completion certificate, you should have:
  - Student User's Guide
  - a photo of your OPAC account
  - title of editorial news and newspaper
  - name of two online databases
  - a selfie with the cover of a book
  - name of material at the AVC
  - name of Davao image in the AC mural
